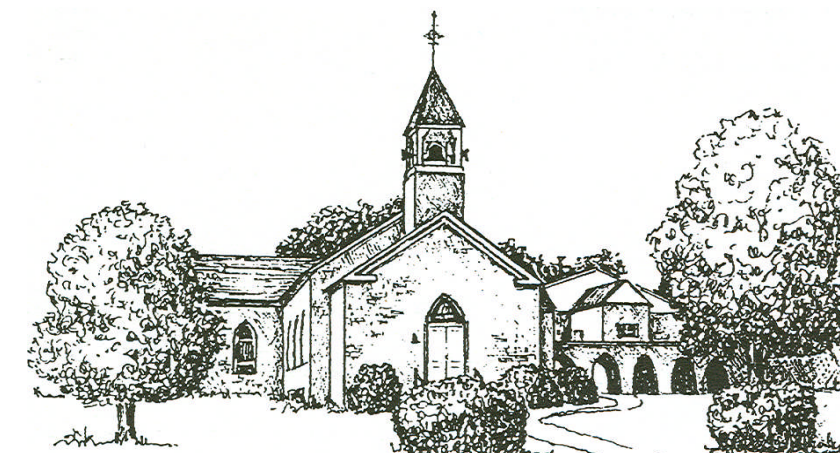

All that we have comes from God, and He has promised to provide for all of our needs, plus enough to be generous in helping others. Will we respond accordingly?
