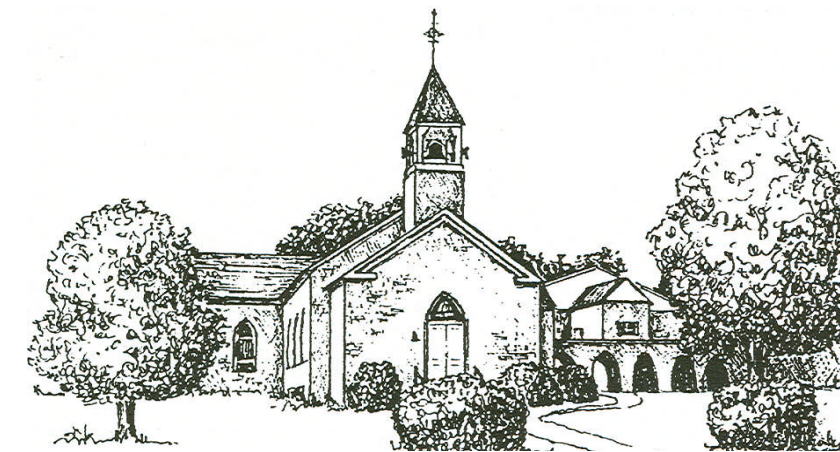

We hope that this can be a helpful tool to gauge how well we are doing financially, and spiritually.

Without a doubt, God wants us to improve our stewardship at Fork Union Baptist Church. Our Stewardship Committee hopes to give us some tools to help us grow in that part of our spiritual lives. All that we have comes from God, and He has promised to provide for all of our needs, plus enough to be generous in helping others. Will we respond accordingly?
